Dear Mr. Maass:

Please allow this correspondence to serve as a response to your Open Records Request, received by DeKalb County Police Department on October 15, 2020, for the following:

- 1. The number of license plates scanned with Flock Safety automated license plate readers over the last 30 days;**
- 2. The names of the hot lists/watch lists used with Flock Safety automated license plate readers;**
- 3. The names of all the agencies with which data is shared with through the Flock Safety automated license plate reader system;**
- 4. The names of all the agencies from which data is received through the Flock Safety automated license plate reader system;**
- 5. All agreements with local homeowner associations or private business or individuals for access to Flock Safety systems;**
- 6. All contracts, MOUs, or other agreements with Flock Safety;**
- 7. All procurement documents related to Flock Safety.**

After reviewing your request, it has been determined that the requested information is subject to release under the Open Records Act.

As provided in O.C.G.A. § 50-18-71, the total estimated cost to search, retrieve and copy the requested documents is **\$51.81**. This includes a charge of \$17.27 per hour with an estimate of three (3) hours (no charge for first 15 minutes) to cover the administrative cost of assisting you with your request. **DO NOT SEND PAYMENT AT THIS TIME**. Please email your Agree to Pay to me and I will begin gathering the documents. Allow up to and including five (5) business days from the day of receiving the Agree to Pay for me to provide the requested information and invoice.
