The Village of Oak Park ("Village") is in receipt of your Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request for:

Records related to the Oak Park Police Department's Flock Safety system:

1. Organization Audit in Flock.

The report should include data logged from the period of June 1, 2024, to the date this request is processed. Per Flock's documentation, the Organization Audit is available within the Insights tab and is defined as searches done within the agency.

2. Network Audit in Flock.

The report should include data logged from the period of June 1, 2024, to the date this request is processed. Per Flock's documentation, the Network Audit is available within the Insights tab and is defined as searches of the organization's Flock network by any agency in the Flock System.

3. A list of network share settings that include:

3a. Flock networks shared with me

3b. Networks that I'm sharing

Your FOIA request is partially denied pursuant to Section 7(1)(d-7) of the FOIA, which provides that the following are exempt from disclosure:

(d-7) Information gathered or records created from the use of automatic license plate readers in connection with Section 2-130 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

5 ILCS 140/7(1)(d-7). The release of the Flock data log and network report from June 1, 2024 would interfere with a reasonably contemplated law enforcement proceeding and obstruct an ongoing criminal investigation.

You have the right of review to the denial of your request by the Public Access Counselor of the Illinois Attorney General's office. In addition, you have the right to apply to the Circuit Court of Cook County for injunctive or declaratory relief.
