Dear Flock Customer,

To help enable compliance with Washington laws that restrict law enforcement agency actions related to immigration enforcement and reproductive health rights protected under Washington law, our Product team has created a new Search filter for your agency. This filter is designed to remove your agency's cameras from any search with a search reason that appears to indicate that the search is connected to immigration enforcement or reproductive care. This filter will apply to all searches performed that include any of your networks, whether by your own employees or other agencies that you have shared with, such as via direct one-to-one sharing and the Statewide and Nationwide Lookup tools.

We intend to turn on the filter for all law enforcement customers in the state of Washington on Friday (August 15th, 2025). If you have any questions or concerns, please let us know.

Flock remains committed to ensuring that agencies can share data in a manner consistent with their community's values and comply with all applicable laws.
