FOIA Section 7 –Exemptions PD 981-2025

- 7(1)(a) – “[i]nformation specifically prohibited from disclosure by federal or State law or rules and regulations implementing federal or State law.”
 - Criminal Code of 2012 and Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 – Including but not limited to Records Under Court Seal, School bus audio-visual recordings, Custodial Interrogations.
 - LEADS Information – “LEADS data shall not be disseminated to any individual or organization that is not legally authorized to have access to the information. The public is not entitled to view or possess data that is transmitted through, received through, or stored in LEADS.
- 7(1)(b) – “[p]rivate information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law, or a court order.”
 - Private Information – is defined as “unique identifiers, including a person’s social security number, driver’s license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses.” Under FOIA, “private information also includes home addresses and personal license plate numbers, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person.” Per the Public Access Opinion 14-015 “a person’s signature is a unique identifier.”
- 7(1)(c) – “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information. "Unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" means the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information. The disclosure of information that bears on the public duties of public employees and officials shall not be considered an invasion of personal privacy.”
 - Personal Information – Including but not limited to date of birth, race, graphic photographs and descriptions of offenses, graphic autopsy photographs of decedent, victims’ name and their identifying information, name of individuals whose photos were used in police line-ups in connection with crimes for which they were not arrested or charged, other third-party names, specific medical information.
- 7(1)(d)(i) – “interfere with pending or actually and reasonably contemplated law enforcement proceedings conducted by any law enforcement or correctional agency that is the recipient of the request[.]”

- 7(1)(d)(ii) – “interfere with active administrative enforcement proceedings conducted by the public body that is the recipient of the request[.]”

- 7(1)(d)(iii) – “create a substantial likelihood that a person will be deprived of a fair trial or an impartial hearing[.]”

- 7(1)(d)(iv) – “unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies; except that the identities of witnesses to traffic crashes, traffic crash reports, and rescue reports shall be provided by agencies of local government, except when disclosure would interfere with an active criminal investigation conducted by the agency that is the recipient of the request[.]” This provision also allows police departments and other law enforcement agencies to protect the anonymity of members of the public who provide them with information, such as witnesses who give statements about potential crimes.

- 7(1)(d)(v) – “disclose unique or specialized investigative techniques other than those generally used and known or disclose internal documents of correctional agencies related to detection, observation, or investigation of incidents of crime or misconduct, and disclosure would result in demonstrable harm to the agency or public body that is the recipient of the request[.]”

- 7(1)(d)(vi) – “endanger the life or physical safety of law enforcement personnel or any other person[.]”
- 7(1)(d)(vii) – “obstruct an ongoing criminal investigation by the agency that is the recipient of the request.”

- 7(1)(e) – “[r]ecords that relate to or affect the security of correctional institutions and detention facilities.” This includes but it is not limited to, video recording of internal sections of a detention facility in which disclosure would jeopardize security by exposing the surveillance system’s blind spots.
- 7(1)(f) – “[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda, and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body.”

- 7.5(bb) – “[i]nformation which is or was prohibited from disclosure by the Juvenile Court Act of 1987.” Under the general provisions of the JCA, “inspection and copying of law enforcement records maintained by law enforcement agencies that relate to a minor who has been investigated, arrested, or taken into custody before his or her 18th birthday” is limited to certain enumerated parties. [UPDATED 7/2023] JCA prohibits disclosure of “juvenile law enforcement records” that contain information about both adults and minors: If a law enforcement record, such as a police report, contains information about both an adult and a minor investigated, arrested, and/or charged with crimes, the record constitutes a “juvenile law enforcement record” that is prohibited from disclosure in its entirety.
- 7.5(cc) – “[r]ecordings made under the Law Enforcement Officer-Worn Body Camera Act, except to the extent authorized under that Act.”
- 7(1)(d-7) Information gathered or records created from the use of automatic license plate readers in connection with Section 2-130 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
- Other Reason – Not listed above:
