The number of license plates scanned with Flock Safety automated license plate readers over the last 30 days; The names of the hot lists/watch lists used with Flock Safety automated license plate readers; The names of all the agencies with which data is shared with through the Flock Safety automated license plate reader system; The names of all the agencies from which data is received through the Flock Safety automated license plate reader system; All agreements with local homeowner associations or private business or individuals for access to Flock Safety systems; All contracts, MOUs, or other agreements with Flock Safety; All procurement documents related to Flock Safety.
