Re: Your Public Records Act Request

Dear Syd Jones:

The Danville Police Department is responding to your record request (the "Request"), which was received via facsimile by the Sheriff's Office Records Unit on November 4, 2025 and was subsequently shared with the Danville Police Department. This response by the Danville Police Department is pursuant to the California Public Records Act ("CPRA"). (Gov. Code § 7920.000 *et seq.*)

Specifically, you requested,

In response to the Request, the Danville Police Department has located its Network Audit report from the period January 1, 2025 to February 1, 2025, which includes the requested information; please refer to the enclosed document. Under the CPRA, portions of the record are exempt from disclosure as records of investigations, which records are exempt indefinitely, even if the investigation has concluded. (Gov. Code §§ 7923.600.) In addition, license plate information has been redacted as this information could be used to identify an individual, which would result in an unwarranted invasion of their personal privacy and because of the compelling public interests in nondisclosure of portions of the information. (Gov. Code §§ 7927.705, 7922.000; Evid. Code § 1040, and Cal. Const., art. I, § 1.)

The public interest served by not disclosing this content in the record clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure so as to protect privacy interests of individuals identified in the record, including names and other personally-identifying information, and criminal investigatory and related information, such as the reason for query, warrants, crimes associated with investigations, and linked to identifiable information about suspects and/or victims of crime. The release of such information may interfere with and compromise investigations of the Danville Police Department and other law enforcement agencies, which could negatively impact public safety and law enforcement operations, and would result in an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy interests of numerous individuals.
